




# A-CBL700 Adapter Installation Instructions

This adapter cable connects up to three wired CabCAM™ cameras to 0E Case-IH AFS Pro 700 & New Holland IntelliView IV monitors.

Follow these instructions carefully. A&I Products is not responsible for damage resulting from improper installation.



#### Step 1

Connect the Power lead (Red +) to 12V power found inside the cab, preferably a switched source of power. Connect the Ground lead (Black -) to a chassis ground within the cab.

#### Step 2

Plug the yellow BNC connector into the back of the AFS Pro 700 or IntelliView IV monitor for Camera 1.

### Step 3

Remove the 26 Pin connector plug from the back of the monitor. There may be factory plugs to prevent dust and foreign objects from getting into in ports 8 & 16. Remove these plugs.

## Step 4

Carefully push the white unlocking tab on the front bottom side of the plug to unlock the pins. The tab only needs to move about .0625" to unlock. MAKE SURE TO NOT PULL OUT ANY OF THE EXISTING PINS! You may want to make a wiring diagram of the plug before unlocking to ensure pins are returned to the correct port should they be removed accidentally.



These two white tabs shown up mean that the pins are unlocked.

### Step 5

Insert the orange and yellow wires into the back of the 26 pin plug. The yellow wire goes into Socket 8 and the orange wire must be installed into Socket 16. These are for Camera 2 and Camera 3. Ensure the pins are pushed all the way in and lock the tabs by pushing down on the two white tabs until they click and are flush with the plug housing.



Insert the orange and yellow wires into Socket 8 & 16.

### Step 6

Plug the 26 pin connector into the back of your Case-IH or New Holland display.

### Step 7

Connect your CabCAM<sup>™</sup> cameras to the three connectors in the A-CBL700 harness either direct or with a 20', 65', or 200' extension cable.

Now you can power up your machine and enjoy three views with A&I Products CabCAM<sup>TM</sup> cameras.
